Legislative & Regulatory Affairs Committee (LRAC):

Charge:

- To develop AAPM policy and an action plan for the execution of strategies to achieve the goals and interests of the members as they relate to the affairs of the federal and state governments and the public sector at large
- To monitor, through its consultants and advisors, the federal and statewide events which have relevance and impact on the treatment of pain

Membership Committee:

Charge:

- To develop and implement strategic marketing plans for recruiting and retaining members
- To recommend membership policy to the Board of Directors
- To conduct periodic needs assessments of the members

Site Selection Committee:

Charge:

- The long-term plan for meeting sites will be established by the board and staff.
- The annual meeting is rotated among the various regions of the country
- The cities are chosen based upon: general appeal of site as a destination, cost of rooms; cost of airfare and ease of access (consideration given to hub cities); cost and ease of ground travel in the area; adequate facilities for the meeting.
